Local Election Results May 2019

Borough Council and Parish Council Elections took place on 2nd May 2019.

Congratulations to Rex Walker who was successful in being re-elected as our local representative on Rushcliffe Borough Council.

There were insufficient nominations for the Kingston on Soar Parish Council posts to require an election. The current Parish Councillors have all volunteered their time for another term and were therefore re-elected unopposed.

At the May annual meeting Mark Johnson was re-elected as Chairman and Gill Aldridge Vice-Chair.
